AIM OF THE CONFERENCE

The share of electricity produced from renewable energy is continuing to increase, both nationally and internationally. The transition to an electricity system based on renewable sources is characterised by an increasing need to provide flexible, demand-driven energy in order to compensate power supply from fluctuating sources, like solar or wind. Bioenergy has the potential to supply peak demands and to provide ancillary services in a flexible, resource- and cost-efficient way. Therefore, the aim of the conference is to highlight and discuss the frameworks, conditions, alternatives and consequences of a demand-driven bioenergy supply in an energy system in transition. In addition to the national and international frameworks, the main focus of the conference is on technological, economic, environmental, social and local issues.
